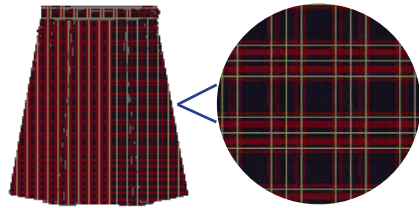

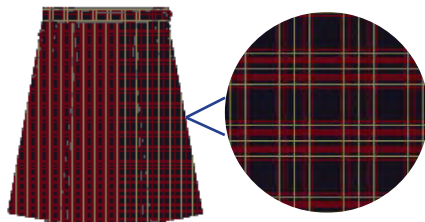

# Uniform Guidelines

## Trans-seasonal

The College uniform is now trans-seasonal, there is no specific winter or summer uniform as per previous years. (With the exception of the Blazer as described below.) Students are required to wear the appropriate uniform for their year level, and may choose to dress for comfort and weather at any time of year. Please remember Sport and Formal uniform are separate and are not to be mixed and matched. (With the exception of the Middle/Senior Encounter jacket and puffer vest which may be worn with Formal uniform in Years 7-9. The Encounter Jacket becomes Sport Uniform ONLY from Year 10.

## Blazers & Ties

Blazers are compulsory for Years 10-12 and must be worn to and from the College during Terms 2 & 3 and for formal/special occasions as directed by a Head of School/Principal or their Delegate. Ties are compulsory for Senior School Boys in Terms 2 & 3. The Blazer must always remain the outer garment.

## Formal Uniform

Uniform that is marked as optional is not part of the formal uniform and is not to be worn on formal occasions unless specifically directed by a Head of School/Principal or their Delegate for special occasions.

## Skirt/Dress Length

The College skirt or dress must be worn at knee length.

## Sport Uniform

Primary School team coloured polos are to be worn on designated PE days and House days.  
Middle and Senior sport uniform is only to be worn on designated PE days or sporting events unless instructed by a teacher.

## Socks and Shoes

Primary (F-6) - Socks must be plain white, shoes must be supportive sport shoes/sneakers (not skate shoes eg. vans or cons)  
Middle/Senior (7-12) Formal - Socks must be plain dark navy, shoes must be standard black lace up school shoes, no Mary Janes or buckle up shoes.  
Middle/Senior (7-12) Sport - Socks must be plain white, shoes must be supportive sport shoes/sneakers (not skate shoes eg. vans or cons)

## Accessories

Plain navy scarves and gloves may be worn  
Navy netball knickers are encouraged under skirts and dresses.

## Make up and Nail polish

No make-up is to be worn in Junior and Middle School.  
Senior School students (Year 10-12) may wear light foundation / tinted moisturizer, preferably with 30+ sunblock rating and light mascara. A natural look must be maintained.  
Nail polish is not permitted.

## Jewellery

One simple plain gold/silver stud or sleeper may be worn in the lower part of the ear lobe. Additional piercings are not permitted.  
A plain light chain with a small cross may be worn around the neck.  
A watch may be worn.  
Bracelets/anklets and rings are not permitted for safety reasons (except for Medic Alert bracelets/necklaces.)

## Hair

Hair is to be clean, neat and tidy and is to be worn away from the face, if longer than shoulder length it must be tied up. Hairstyles will not draw unnecessary attention to individuals and will be in keeping with the broader Uniform Policy. Hair accessories are to be College colours only, red navy and white. No facial hair is permitted.
